## WOULD THE COMPACT BENEFIT YOUR BUSINESS?

**Do you provide telehealth services?** Increase your telehealth presence in multiple states!

**Do you recruit (or want to recruit) travel therapists?** Widen your pool of applicants and fill specific staffing needs!

**Do you have clinics in multiple states, especially in border states?** Be able to flex your clinic staff across state lines!

A PT/PTA licensed in a compact state can more quickly start working in another compact state through a compact privilege instead of a state license.

## OTHER EMPLOYER BENEFITS

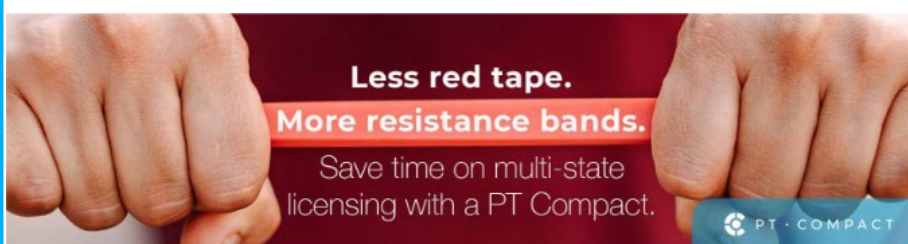
- Simplifies multi-state applications

- Rapid authorization to practice (within 10 minutes)
- Often less expensive than traditional license

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Home state is an active compact state
- Active PT/PTA license in the home state
- No disciplinary actions in the past 2 years
- No active encumbrance on any license

\*Some states also have a jurisprudence requirement\*
