A compact privilege is the legal equivalent of a state-issued license.

An individual's home state is their permanent residence.

WOULD THE COMPACT BENEFIT YOUR BUSINESS?

Do you provide telehealth services? Increase your telehealth presence in multiple states!

Do you recruit (or want to recruit) travel therapists? Widen your pool of applicants and fill specific staffing needs!

Do you have clinics in multiple states, especially in border states? Be able to flex your clinic staff across state lines!

A PT/PTA licensed in a compact state can more quickly start working in another compact state through a compact privilege instead of a state license.

OTHER EMPLOYER BENEFITS

- Simplifies multi-state applications
- Simplifies tracking CEU requirements
- Simplifies tracking RENEWAL dates
- Rapid authorization to practice (within 10 minutes)
- Often less expensive than traditional license

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Home state is an active compact state
- Active PT/PTA license in the home state
- No disciplinary actions in the past 2 years
- No active encumbrance on any license

Some states also have a jurisprudence requirement
